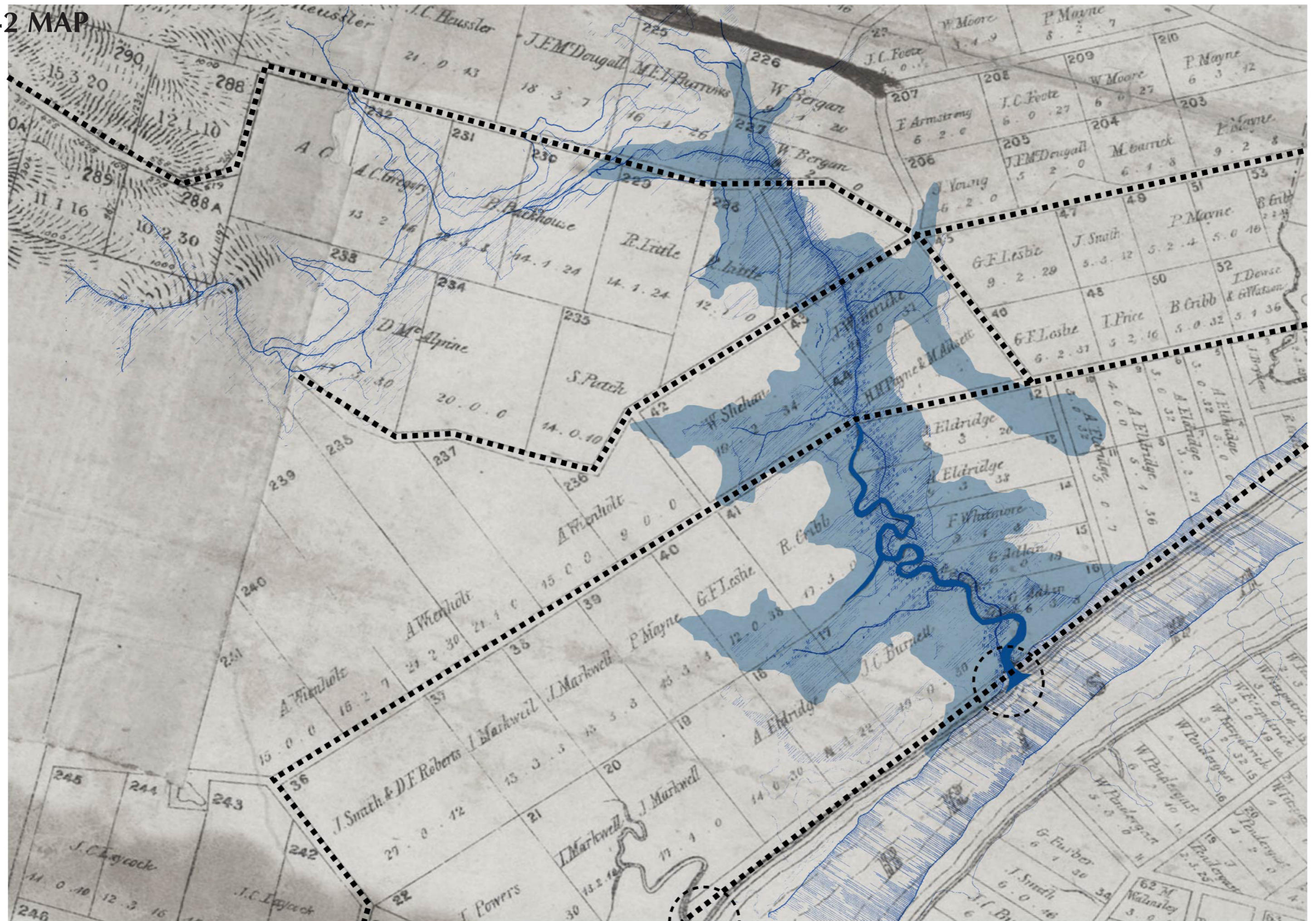

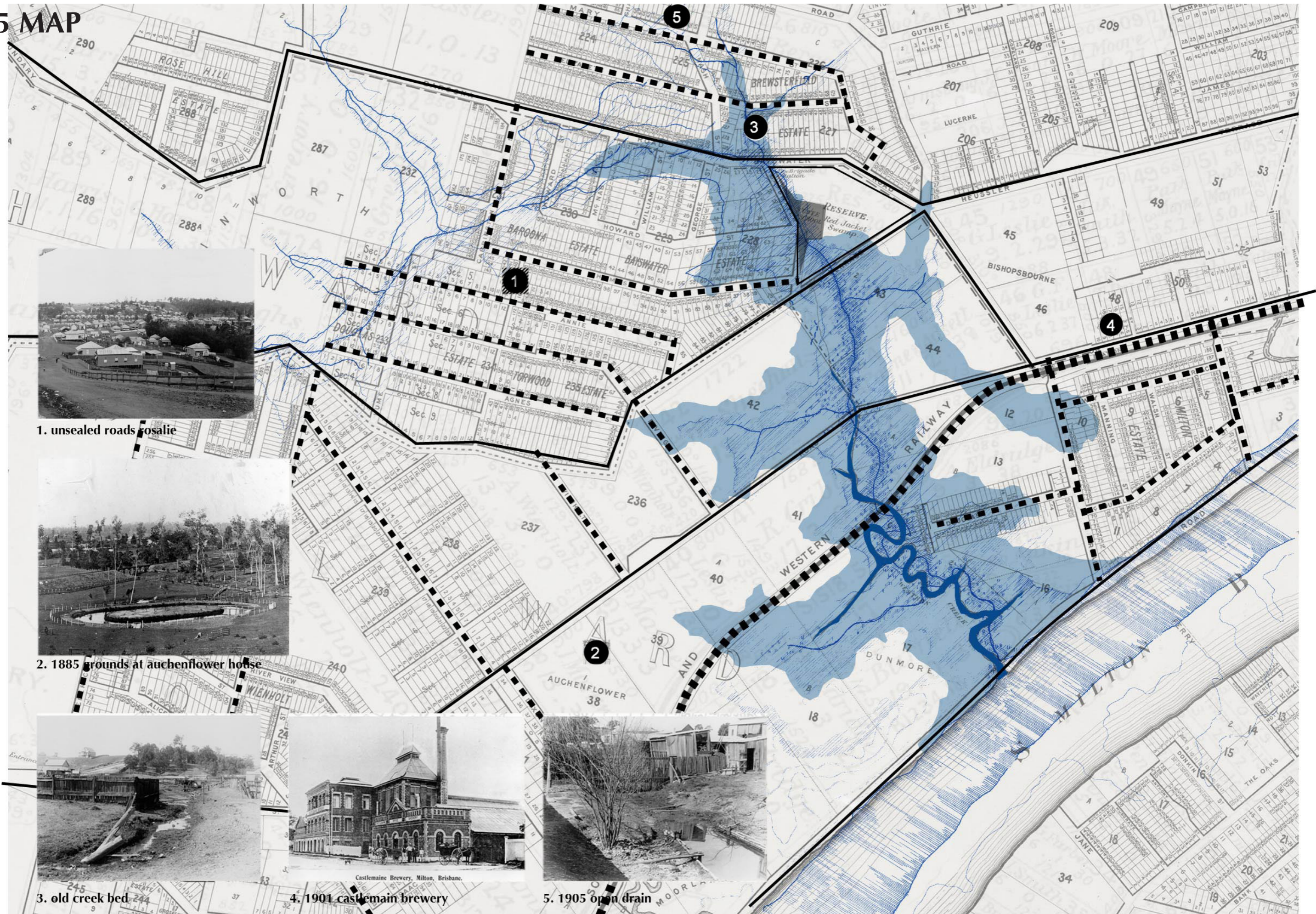

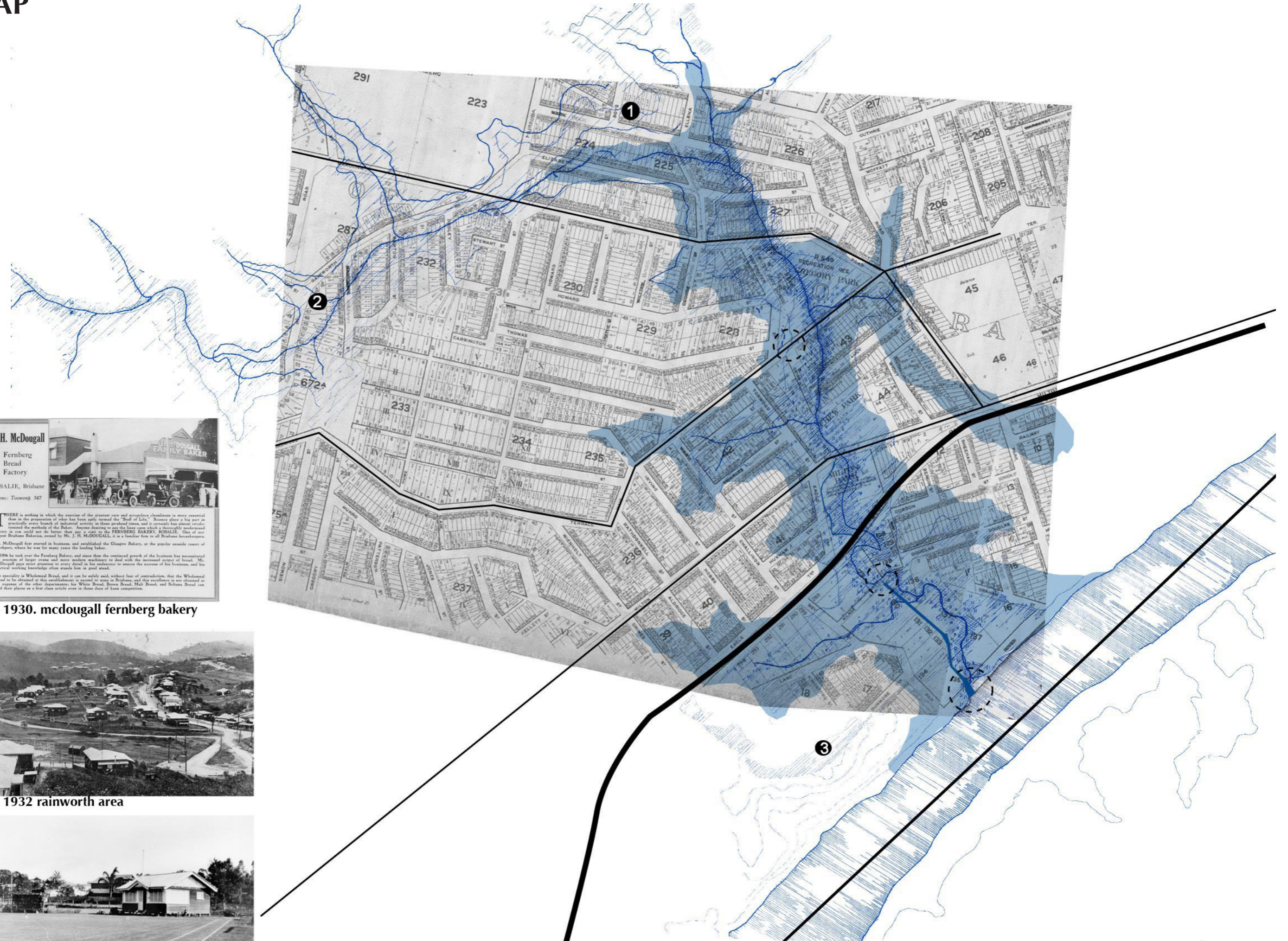

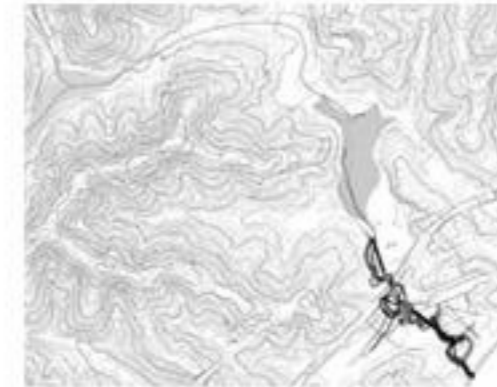

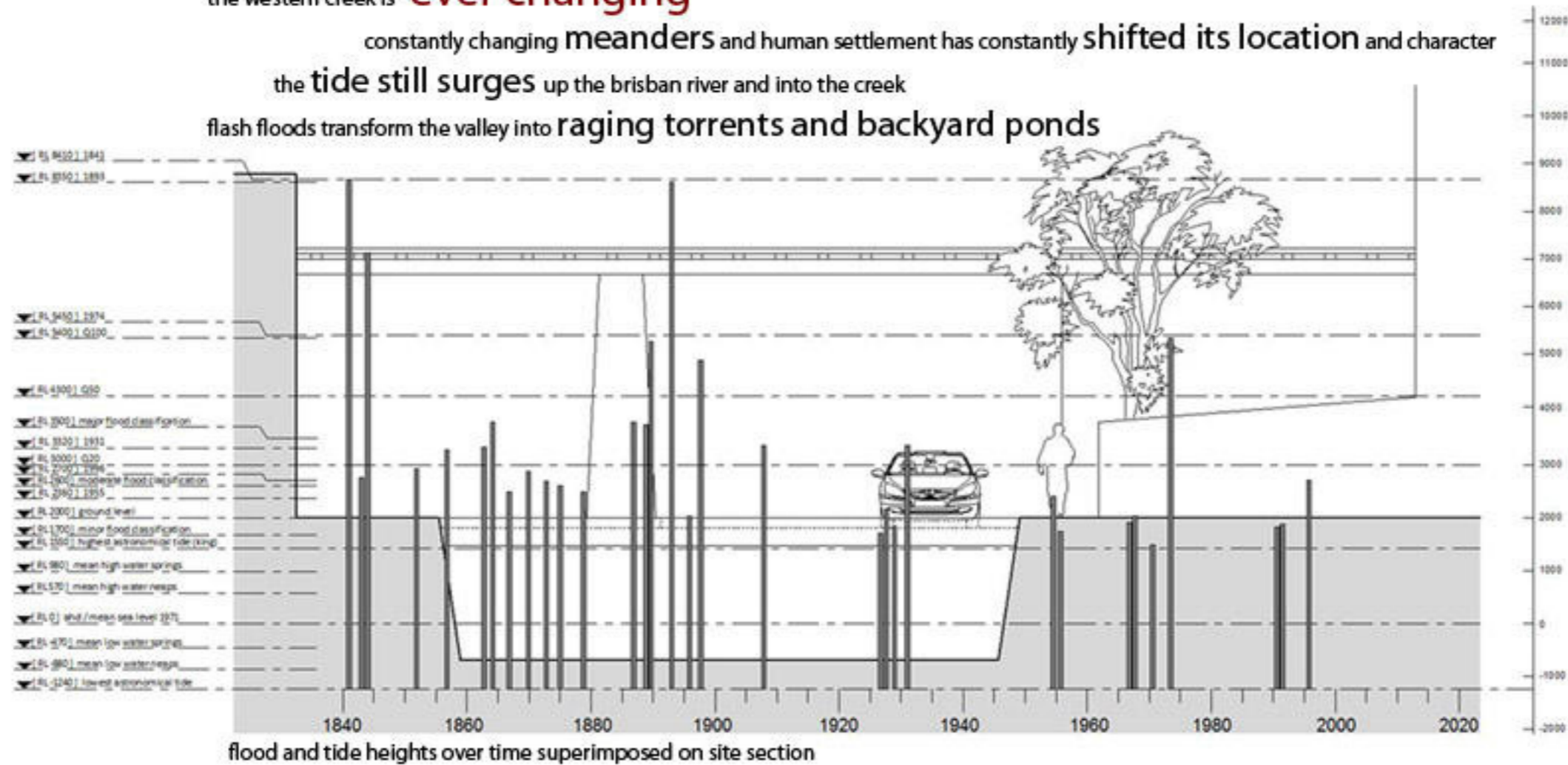
creek and swamps 1850 - 2009
